CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS

Parents/carers have a great influence on children's enjoyment and success in swimming and we need to remember, that however proficient a child becomes within the club, it is important to reinforce the message that positive attitudes will improve the experience for everyone involved.

Parents are asked to show their children, by their own example, that it is important to show respect for everyone they meet in swimming. Please remember this in your dealings with: the coaching team and the administrators of the club

2. A parents/spectators expectations and attitude have a significant bearing on a child's attitude towards;

- Other Swimmers
- Officials
- Managers
- Spectators

3. Ensure that parents/spectators within the club are always positive and encouraging towards all the children, not just their own. Parents/spectators are encouraged to;

- Applaud the competition as well as your own team
- Avoid coaching the child during galas or training sessions
- Not shout and scream
- Give attention to each of the children involved not just the most talented
- Give encouragement to everyone who participates in Swimming

4. Ensure parents/spectators within the club agree and adhere to the clubs code of conduct and child protection policy.

5. Parents who accept membership of the club for their child are bound by the contents of this Code of Conduct.
